



# Awards

## 2026 CONDITIONS

The Goulburn Valley Reining Horse Association (GVRHA) Hi Point year runs as per calendar year. During 2026, points will be allocated from the following shows: **February, March, April, May (Water Wheel Reining Classic), August and September.**

To be eligible riders must be a current Full financial member/Life member/ Youth of the GVRHA at the time of showing.

GVRHA Hi Point Awards will be calculated based upon **the cumulative scores** from the relevant class at each Show, **with a minimum of 3 Shows** entered for eligibility.

GVRHA High Point Awards will be presented at the November Show.

Eligibility will be awarded on a 'one horse-one rider' combination in the following categories:

- Rookie (whether entered Lvl1,Lvl 2 or both)
- Primetime Rookie
- Rookie Professional
- Limited Non Pro
- Limited Open
- Intermediate Non Pro
- Intermediate Open
- Non Pro
- Open
- Youth 13 Years & Under
- Youth 14 – 18 Years
- Prime Time Non Pro
- Para Reining
- Masters Non Pro

Points will be awarded to the 'horse' in the following categories:

- Novice Horse Non Pro
- Novice Horse Open

The highest total of scores from each category will receive an end of year Hi Point Champion Award. Runner Ups will receive a certificate.

**Hi Point Certificates also awarded to:** GVRHA Short Stirrup, GVRHA Junior Horse, GVRHA Senior Horse, GVRHA Equine Legends winners and runners up.

If a final equal total of points results in a category, the winner will be determined by the highest aggregate scores over the year in that category.
