



# Run For A Million Qualifier - Australia

Held in conjunction with the Water Wheel Reining Classic

12–16 May 2026 | Tatura Park, Tatura VIC

## 1. Overview

This event provides Australian competitors the opportunity to qualify for the Run For A Million Finals to be held 9–15 August 2026 in Las Vegas, Nevada, USA. The qualifier will be conducted during the Water Wheel Reining Classic show program.

## 2. Divisions

- Rookie 1
- Rookie 2
- Non Pro
- Youth

## 3. Competitor Entry Fee

Qualifier Entry Fee: \$440 AUD per division. This fee is additional to the Water Wheel Reining Classic class entry fees.

Entries Close: In accordance with the Water Wheel Reining Classic Show Conditions.

Late Entries: Late entries will only be accepted from competitors already entered in the Water Wheel Reining Classic and must be received at the Show Office prior to 4:00 pm the day before the class.

## 4. Youth Qualifying Process

4.1 Youth 13 & Under and Youth 14–18 competitors will run the same pattern and be judged by the same judges.

4.2 For the purposes of qualification, scores from both youth divisions will be combined.

4.3 Only competitors who have paid the Youth Qualifier Entry Fee will be included in the qualifier results.

4.4 The Top 5 highest scoring competitors plus ties from the combined eligible scores will qualify for the Run For A Million Youth Finals.

4.5 Placings within the individual Water Wheel Reining Classic Youth classes at the show remain separate; qualification is determined from the combined qualifier scores.

## **5. Rookie 1, Rookie 2 & Non Pro Qualifying Process**

5.1 Rookie 1, Rookie 2 will be run concurrent however scored and placed independently.

5.2 Non Pro will be run, scored and placed independently

5.3 Only competitors who have paid the official Qualifier Entry Fee will be eligible for qualification.

5.4 The Top 5 placed competitors in each division will qualify for the Run For A Million Finals.

## **6. Run For A Million Finals**

6.1 The Finals will be held 9–15 August 2026 in Las Vegas, Nevada, USA.

6.2 Rookie 1, Rookie 2 and Non Pro classes will run independently at the Finals.

6.3 The Youth Finals is an unrestricted Youth class and is not divided into age groups.

## **7. Competitor Responsibilities**

Successful qualifiers are responsible for sourcing a horse and covering all expenses related to participation in the Run For A Million Finals, including but not limited to:

- TRFAM event entry
- Flights, accommodation and meals
- Horse lease or hire and transport
- Training and associated costs

## **8. TRFAM Finals Entry Fees (Las Vegas)**

Rookie 1 and Rookie 2: \$100 USD

Non Pro: \$200 USD

Youth: No entry fee
